Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 73 residents and 43 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Unfortunately, we received confirmation that one staff member tested positive January 6, 2021. The employee had not been in the facility since December 18th but was tested for COVID the day she returned to the facility and the result was positive. The employee did not provide any direct patient care and is quarantining at home for the required amount of time.

Our community/county positivity rate is at 12.2%.

Our first Walgreens Clinic was held on December 30th with good turnout. Our second clinic is scheduled for January 20th and our last clinic will be February 10th. You will be receiving an additional letter with consent documents for the 2nd vaccine if your loved one received his/her first vaccination.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility and notification that we received confirmation today that one staff member tested positive for COVID-19, which brings our total number of cases since the onset of this pandemic to 73 residents and 45 staff members that have tested positive for COVID-19. Our community statistic continue to be high at 14.%, thus we will continue to test all staff twice a week and residents once a week. We also test for both residents and residents as needed.
